

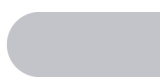

## Tournament Rules & Regulations

Rules can be subject to changes leading up to the event if the Organizer deems necessary. The Organizer asks all participants to check the rules & regulations prior to the event in order to avoid any confusion. ### Conditions of Participation

#### 1. Rules

- 1.1. The rules of reference are those of the *Royal & Ancient & the USGA*
- 1.2. Each team will need to meet the requirements of the Amateur Statute Rules.

#### 2. For Team Members

2.1. Each national team consists of two team members who won the 1<sup>st</sup> place in their national qualification, or one player who finished first in the 1<sup>st</sup> category and one player who finished first in the 2<sup>nd</sup> category. In case one of the first players withdraws, LeClub Golf International (LCI) is granted the right to qualify another player who participated in the qualification tournament.

2.2. Each team member will need to be at least 18 years old or legal age in his country the day of the national final tournament.

#### 2.3. Categories:

The categories will be mixed.

- The 1<sup>st</sup> category brings together male and female players with a handicap equal or under 14.9.
- The 2<sup>nd</sup> category brings together all players with a handicap equal or over 15.0

The category which will be considered will be the one which the players holds at the time of the national qualification final.

#### 2.4. Handicap:

Each national promoter will have the responsibility of notifying LCI the qualified updated players' handicaps.

The decimals of the Handicap will be rounded as follows:

- 0,1-0,2-0,3-0,4 will be rounded to the lower whole number
- 0,5-0,6-0,7-0,8-0,9 will be rounded to the whole number above.

A player with handicap 24.0 or higher may attend but his/her hcp will be limited to 24.0.

Note: in case of non-eligibility, the player will be disqualified.



**The handicap of each player will be updated after each stableford round.**

A player scoring 3 down his handicap the first day will play with 3 handicap point less, the 2<sup>nd</sup> day.

The handicap can't involve by increasing.

To calculate the scramble handicap, it will be considered the classification of the two first rounds of competition with is calculated by gross + net.

## Game Format

### 3. Official tournament:

**54 holes**

1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> round: 18 holes / individual stableford

3<sup>rd</sup> round: 18 holes / two players scramble in stableford

The ranking is established by adding up the following scores of each national team:

- 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> round: gross score + net score of each player
- 3<sup>rd</sup> round: gross score + net score

For each round, every team and players win some points for the final ranking according to your ranking of your round.

The classification gross score + net of each round give point for the final ranking :

- 1<sup>st</sup> round 1<sup>st</sup> = 50 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 47 pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 44 pts, 4<sup>th</sup> = 41 pts, 5<sup>th</sup> = 38 pts, 6<sup>th</sup> = 35 pts, 7<sup>th</sup> to last one = 30 pts
- 2<sup>nd</sup> round : 1<sup>st</sup> = 75 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 70 pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 65 pts, 4<sup>th</sup> = 60 pts, 5<sup>th</sup> = 55 pts, 6<sup>th</sup> = 50 pts, 7<sup>th</sup> to last one = 45 pts
- 3<sup>rd</sup> round : 1<sup>st</sup> = 100 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 90 pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 80 pts, 4<sup>th</sup> = 70 pts, 5<sup>th</sup> = 60 pts, 6<sup>th</sup> = 50 pts, 7<sup>th</sup> to last one : 45 pts

### 4. The invitational:

**54 holes**

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> round: 18 holes / individual stableford

The ranking is made by adding up:

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> round: gross score + net score

For each round, every players win some points for the final ranking according to your ranking of your round.

### 5. Shots Received:

The system used to calculate the shots received in Scramble in Stableford will be explained at the tournament presentation meeting before the start of the tournament.

### 6. Tiebreaker:

In the case of a tie, the tiebreaker will be done over the highest total of the hardest hole of the course (handicap 1), in the case of another tie, it will be done on the best total on the second hardest hole (handicap 2), then the 3<sup>rd</sup> hardest hole and so on... until the tie is broken.

### 7. Pace of play

Players could be penalized if they do not respect the pace of play.



## Commitments

8. Entries must be submitted to the AGWC organization by the promoters of each national qualification tournament taking part in the AGWC. Entries are free of charge.

## Recording

9. Every player will need to register at the tournament office the day before the tournament or two days before the 1<sup>st</sup> round, in the case they do not register they can be disqualified. Registration via phone-call will be accepted.

## Practice

10. Practice is allowed in the Golf Course only during the practice round, one day before the competition. Training in the practice areas is allowed.

## Event Committee

11. The Event Committee will be comprised of the Amateur Golf World Cup organization team and an official on-course Referee.

## Official Board

12. Only the information displayed on the official event board will act as official information.

## Measurement Tools & Caddies

13. All distance measuring equipment will be allowed, except from equipment which measure height differences.

14. Each player might be accompanied by only one amateur caddy, who can not be a professional caddy or a professional golfer.

15. A player who is not accompanied by an amateur caddy, may receive advice from the other player on the team.

### Official Tournament:

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Team

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Individual in each category (2 categories)

### The invitational:

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Individual
